We have a few messages to share with you, including some dates for diary!

Firstly, thank you for supporting our Covid measures. The majority of our Westwood Family are working with us to ensure we are all keeping ourselves safe, following the guidance and our school open. So, we ask you to please refer to the handbook for parents for full details.

It has been very busy around our school since Monday 15th March especially at home times and morning drop offs; some parents are coming to school very early and waiting for a long time before they drop off/pick up. We have staggered times to alleviate the volume of parents and children around the site and to decrease any contact. So please can you come as close to your child's pick up / drop off time as possible - keep our school Covid safe and our school open. Thank you.

Another reminder of other key Covid measures include:

- Wearing a mask on and around the school site- if you are unable to wear a mask, please use your lanyards. We had this organized brilliantly before Christmas. Since our return in February, many parents are not wearing a mask and standing outside, by the wall this causes congestion problems. Please remember your mask or lanyard and come onto the school site at home time if you are in Bubbles A, B, C & D.
- ✓ Keeping your 2-meter distance and keeping the pavements outside school clear.
- \checkmark One adult on site to collect your child/children. Keeping your child close and safe, on and around the site.
- ✓ Parking away and safely from the school site and making use of the car parks.
- ✓ Scooters and bikes are not allowed on the school site for health and safety reasons.
- ✓ <u>Dropping off at your correct times and picking up promptly.</u>

Due to Covid 19, these appointments will be held over Zoom – once you have confirmed your slot, and the bookings close, your child's class teacher will send you a link to join them online through Zoom for your appointment. Thank you for your support.
