We have had so many events recently and even more exciting opportunities to come!!

We had Nursery Induction event on Monday 24th June with our amazing Early Years Team and lots of professionals who support Westwood so well! It was great to see so many new faces at the event and we have 29 children starting our Nursery next academic year! At the Nursery Induction event we launched our Partnership with Penguins, who currently run the Playgroup in the Westwood Centre. We are very excited to be working together to offer wrap around care for Nursery aged children from September. There will be a Nursery Breakfast Club starting at 7.45am until 8.40 at £2. During the Penguins play group sessions, our expert resident Super Nannies — Mrs Quirk & Mrs Thomas will be working with Kirsty Jones, Delyth Parry and Jen Evans to deliver high quality wrap around care and outstanding child led experiences! Penguins will also be overseeing the afterschool club too.

Penguins are also holding a Coffee morning & Drop in session for all parents of children from 2 to 4 to sign up for Penguins on Friday 28th June. Also at the event will be the Child Care Offer team, who can support you in claiming your 30 hours free child care for 3–4 year olds. Mrs Quirk & Mrs Thomas are holding their next Stay & Play session on Wednesday 3rd July in the Westwood Centre Hall from 9.30am to 11am in readiness for their new weekly Wednesday Mother & Toddler Sessions starting in September - so spread the word and more details about this will follow!! Don't forget if you have a child of Nursery age in September and you haven't applied yet, please do so on the Flintshire website. Remember Penguins are also taking on children from the age of 2 to 4! They are filling up fast!!



#### Our school will receive £500 for every ton collected (50p/kg)



### Westwood


Our Governors play a vital role at Westwood and this month, we have had two fabulous visits. Reverend Rosemary came along to see our wonderful school in action and to talk to learners.
