Since our return to school after Easter, we outlined our Covid 19 routines and expectations in our Westwood Family Handbook and Risk assessment. Some of the key points were:

Please keep your family close and safe around the school site at all time.

- Social distancing wherever possible on the school grounds is recommended but not compulsory.
- Wearing a face covering is recommended for drop off and pick up on the school grounds but not compulsory.
- Visitors inside the setting will be expected to wear a face covering.
- Please refrain from congregating around the school gate and keep the pavements clear in the morning at drop off and at collection of your child/children.

NOTE: Please try not bring cycles and scooters to school at this time, as we cannot store them. We will provide a safe place for these to be brought and stored after June half term. Thank you for your support.

If you have other family members coming to school to collect, please remind them of these requests. Please refrain from sending your child into school if they display symptoms of Covid 19 or test positive for Covid 19. Please refer to the handbook for details of our safety measures and we will update you regularly. You can also contact 119 for advice too. Please also keep to the drop off and pick up times – a few families are consistently arriving late and this is very unsettling for the children, disruptive to our staff and for our school routines. If you need support with punctuality, speak to Mrs. Thomas or Mrs. Williams. Keep to our times please.

Social Media Settings

Most social media apps are 13+ (WhatsApp is 16+) but - as we are aware some children are using them regularly - we wanted to share some important settings to keep children safe online.



GROUPS: allows you to stop a contact being able to add you to groups (recommended for when a friend adds you without permission)

BLOCKED: can add a contact to a blocked list so they can't message you.

You can also block or report a contact/ number by clicking on the chat with them, clicking on their number/name at the top then scrolling down!

Comments that may have offensive words in (recommended: on) You can also block, report or remove a

Tiktok

PRIVATE ACCOUNT: when this is on, only

followers can see your posts and you have to

approve followers (recommended: on)

SAFETY: Tiktok has lots of options to restrict

contact and interaction with video posts

(recommended: friends)

COMMENT FILTERS: you can automatically hide

follower by clicking on their profile and clicking the three dots in the top right hand corner.



CONTACT: decide who can message you and send you snaps (recommended: my friends)

VIEW MY STORY: restrict who can see your story (recommended: my friends)

GHOST MODE: if this isn't on, contacts can see your location on a map (recommended: on)

You can also block or report a user by locating their contact, tapping and holding their name and clicking more

REMINDER- Warning! Huggy Wuggy—Please read carefully

It has come to our attention that a new character is being accessed by school children across the UK. Many schools are issuing an urgent warnings to parents and carers as young pupils have been watching videos featuring a character called 'Huggy Wuggy' from a horror game and then mimicking the clips.



Some schools have said children have been accessing the upsetting videos, which feature a razor-toothed monster from the video game Poppy Playtime, through YouTube and TikTok.

One clip shows the creepy 'Huggy Wuggy' singing about "hugging and killing" and asking viewers to "take their last breath". Some young children in schools have been copying the character. This is very upsetting!!!

Please be vigilant – if your child accesses Youtube or Tik Tok, please be alert; ensure you can check their content and avoid such distressing media. Thank you.
